The St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department (“the SLMPD”) appeals from the judgment of the trial court granting Arbab Adum’s (“Adum”) petition for expungement. The SLMPD argues the trial court erred in granting Adum’s petition to expunge because Adum failed as a matter of law to prove his arrest was based on false information and failed to prove there was no probable cause at the time of the petition to expunge to believe he committed the offense as required by Section 610.122.

REVERSED.

Division Two holds: The trial court erred in granting Adum’s petition to expunge.
