Before Division Three Judges: Ellis, P.J., Hardwick and Dandurand, JJ.

Michael Craig appeals from his conviction for driving while intoxicated, following a guilty plea. He challenges the factual basis for the allegations of his prior conviction in the charging information.

DISMISSED.

Division Three holds: The appeals court lacks jurisdiction to consider Craig's claim following a guilty plea. Complaints concerning the evidentiary basis of the trial court's finding are only subject to review by post-conviction motion and not by direct appeal. The appeal is dismissed.
