Karen Hebert filed a motion to remove the guardian and conservator of her sister, Mary Lou Schieber, and filed a motion to remove Mrs. Schieber's court-appointed counsel. The probate court dismissed Ms. Hebert's motion to remove the guardian and conservator for lack of standing and denied Ms. Hebert's motion to remove court-appointed counsel. Ms. Hebert appeals.

DISMISSED.

Division One holds:

Where Ms. Hebert did not qualify as an "interested person" as defined by section 472.010(15), she lacked standing to appeal the probate court's dismissal of her motion to remove Mrs. Schieber's guardian and conservator and the court's denial of her motion to remove appointed counsel.
