K.D. obtained a full order of protection against Theodore Alosi, which he did not appeal. Subsequently, K.D. sought to renew the order of protection. The trial court granted the petition and entered a judgment renewing the full order of protection. Alosi appeals.

DISMISSED.

Division Three holds:

Shortly after Alosi filed his appellate brief, the six-month full order of protection expired. Because the order of protection expired before the appeal was submitted, the appeal is moot. Moot cases must be dismissed unless an exception applies. We find no exception that would justify our review. Therefore, the appeal is dismissed.
