David Leonard appeals from the circuit court's judgment dismissing his petition for "Writ of Mandamus, Judicial Enforcement Under 610.027, MSL [Missouri Sunshine Law], FOIA [Freedom of Information Act] and Brady." After a hearing, the circuit court dismissed Leonard's petition and held that Leonard had previously litigated the same issues and was unsuccessful.

DISMISSED.

Division Two holds:

Appellant's failure to furnish appellate court with a transcript of the proceedings from which he appeals and failure of appellant to substantially comply with appellate briefing requirements precludes review.
