Shaloma Fansler appeals the Judgment and Full Order of Child Protection entered against her with regard to the minor child, C.C. Fansler contends the evidence was insufficient to prove the elements required for a child protection order pursuant to Sections 455.501 and 455.516, RSMo Supp. 2009.

AFFIRMED.

Division Four holds: There was sufficient evidence in the record to support a finding that Fansler was an "adult household member" in that she was over the age of eighteen and she resided in the same home with C.C. The evidence was also sufficient to prove that Fansler "abused" C.C. by spanking him in an unreasonable manner and causing physical injury. These elements supported the issuance of a child protection order against Fansler.
