Greer Summary

Eddie Greer appeals the circuit court’s denial of his Motion for Reconsideration of Post-Conviction Motion for Forensic DNA Testing, and Motion for Court Ordered Evidentiary Hearing. Greer contends that the circuit court clearly erred by denying his motion for reconsideration without ordering the State to show cause why the motion should not be granted, by failing to grant an evidentiary hearing, and by issuing its final judgment without adequate findings of fact and conclusions of law.

REMANDED FOR DISMISSAL

Division Four holds:

Greer’s claims were previously adjudicated on the merits and his attempts to relitigate those claims are barred by collateral estoppel and should have been dismissed by the motion court.
