David Nicol appeals the circuit court's judgment in Ellen Nicol's cause of action for dissolution of the parties' marriage.

APPEAL DISMISSED

Division Three holds:

David Nicol's brief repeatedly violates Rule 84.04's requirements concerning the contents of briefs. The failure to substantially comply with Rule 84.04 preserves nothing for review. Although we prefer to decide cases on the merits, we feel compelled to dismiss Nicol's appeal because his brief is woefully deficient and because he disregarded this court's invitation to amend his deficient points relied on.
