The Treasurer of the State of Missouri as Custodian of the Second Injury Fund (SIF) appeals the final award of the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission granting employee Daryl Majors permanent total disability benefits, medical expenses, and future medical care for a 2012 work injury. SIF contends that the Commission erred in awarding permanent total disability benefits to Majors because Majors did not meet the statutory requirements for such benefits.

AFFIRMED

Special Division holds:

The Commission did not err in awarding permanent total disability benefits to Majors. The record reflects competent and substantial evidence supporting the Commission's decision.
