The husband, David Atchley, appeals the dissolution judgment entered by the Circuit Court of St. Charles County, which *inter alia*, awarded \$1,500 per month in modifiable maintenance to the wife, Christi Atchley, and awarded her sole legal custody and joint physical custody of the parties' two children.

AFFIRMED IN PART AND REVERSED AND REMANDED IN PART.

DIVISION THREE HOLDS: We conclude that the trial court erred in its maintenance award. Thus, we reverse the maintenance award and remand so that the parties may present additional evidence, as necessary, and the trial court shall reconsider the award in view of income-producing property awarded the wife, daycare and other expenses for the children erroneously included in calculating the wife's expenses, the wife's expected insurance costs, and the wife's student-loan debt. Because reconsideration of the maintenance award could affect the child-support award, we also reverse the child-support award and remand for reconsideration. We affirm the trial court's judgment in all other respects.
