

INSTRUCTIONS

One copy of any new application should be received by each member of the Twenty-First Judicial Circuit Commission by 5 p.m. May 4, 2011. **All applicants, including those who submitted applications for Judge Kintz's vacancy, will need to submit a complete application for the new commission member.** Until a new commission member is named, the fifth copy should be sent to Judge Richter, who will forward it to the new Commission member when that member is appointed. For imaging purposes, *applications should be bound by paper clips or binder clips only.* The commission members are as follows:

Applicants should be aware that interviews will be held in public during the period of June 8 through 10, 2011. The commission will contact applicants after May 4, 2011, to notify them of the time and dates of the interviews.

Applicants should ask the persons listed as references to write a letter to the chief judge, with a copy to each commissioner, stating their opinion of the applicant's judicial qualifications. *Do not* use judges as references.

Applicants should attach a brief biographical sketch to their application for publication purposes in the event the applicant is selected as one of the three nominees. A copy of the applications of the three nominees submitted to the governor will be made public within 72 hours of submitting the certificate of nomination; personal or confidential information will be redacted.
