What Constitutes Violation of Curfew:

A minor would be in violation of a curfew ordinance if he/she were to walk, drive, ride or loiter in or upon a public street, establishment or any other unsupervised place without a lawful cause or emergency or when not accompanied by a parent, legal guardian or other adult person having the care and custody of such minor after the designated curfew hour established by such municipal ordinance.

Parental / Guardian Liability:

Some municipal ordinance go beyond mere accountability for the minor and attach some liability to the parent/guardian for failing to exercise appropriate supervision or for knowingly allowing the juvenile to be out in excess of the designated curfew hour.

Note Well:

A minor is subject to the curfew ordinance applicable to the specific municipality in which he/she were to be stopped. All curfew ordinances are not alike and they are subject to change.
