New Beginnings Counseling Group, Inc. screens and assesses every individual seeking treatment services with Saint Joseph Metro Treatment Center. The Addiction Severity Index is utilized during the initial assessment. When the Addiction Severity Index indicators identify heavy and /or long term use of opiates, an additional assessment tool will be used such as Clinical Opiate Withdrawal Scale. The use of this tool will determine patient appropriateness for referral to a medication assisted treatment program for services. The following protocol is used when scores on these assessment tools indicate current opiate withdrawal: New Beginnings Counseling Group Inc. staff will contact St. Francis Hospital and Health Services for further assessment and treatment as required. Once the patient is stabilized additional referrals for the patient to receive medication assisted treatment services will be made to provider of these services.

All patients referred to a Medication Assisted Treatment provider will sign an authorization to release confidential information which will allow for consultation and communication between New Beginnings Counseling Group, Inc and the specialized service provider.

The authorization to release confidential information will provide for two way communication which will facilitate coordination of treatment services between programs. New Beginnings Counseling Group, Inc and the medication assisted treatment provider shall consult on patient progress regularly, but at least every 30 days.
