ORDER

WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention have declared that the outbreak of COVID-19 is a worldwide pandemic, and the St. Louis County Executive has, accordingly, declared a state of emergency;

WHEREAS, the Missouri Supreme Court has instructed courts in this state to “prepare for potential infection in their community”;

WHEREAS, the Missouri Supreme Court has directed its courts to “consider strategies to prevent the spread of respiratory germs into, within, and between facilities.”

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, effective Monday, March 23, 2020, and until further order of this court, that:

The Brentwood Municipal Court office will be closed to the public from Monday, March 23, 2020 until further notice. During this time, individuals may reach Court staff at 314-963-8623.

Pending further direction from the Missouri Supreme Court and the Presiding Judge of the 21st Circuit, all regularly scheduled court dockets have been postponed.
