WHEREAS, the Court can perform essential functions using electronic and telephonic means,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Court orders as follows:

1. This Order is in effect immediately;
2. Face-to-face access to the court facility shall only be by scheduled appointment by scheduling appointments by contacting the Clerk of the Court by telephone and shall only take place as determined appropriate by the court administrator and by current City policy as to the health and safety of court personnel;
3. All other access shall be by telephone or other electronic means;
4. The court docket scheduled for May 13, 2020 at 5:00 p.m. is hereby continued to the July 15, 2020 5:00 p.m. docket; and
5. The court administrator is ordered to post access methods to the court administrator as stated herein on the city website, as well as the notice of the docket changes, to issue a press release to the local media of this Order, notify Presiding Judge Shane T. Alexander of the 7th Circuit Court of the State of Missouri and notify the Supreme Court of Missouri of the existence of this order.
