


Treatment Court Program Status

As of December 31, 2019, there were 137 treatment court programs in 45 judicial circuits: 80 adult, 4 juvenile, 15 family, 23 designated DWI and 15 veterans treatment court programs serving 40 counties. The commission provides funding to 133 of these programs in 43 judicial circuits.

Treatment Court Program Participants

During the 2019 reporting period, 7,613 individuals participated in a treatment court program.




Treatment Court Program Participant Admissions by Case Type Category for Calendar Year-to-Date*

In addition, for treatment court program participants admitted since the beginning of calendar year 2019:


- The average age at admission was 34 years old.
