Descriptions of Table Headings:

Statute - The chapter and section of the Revised Missouri Statutes (RSMo) that relate to a particular charge code.

Type - Juvenile charge codes are designated as "Juv".

Class - Not Applicable

MO Charge Code - The charge code number assigned to a particular offense.

NCIC Code - Not Applicable

F/P OCN - Not Applicable

Description - The charge code description that relates to a particular offense or jurisdictional ground.

The description is limited to 115-characters due to spacing issues.

Case Type - J=Juvenile. "Case Type" is used by OSCA to categorize various cases for management purpose.

· ***Courts Using JIS use the following case types :***

- o Juvenile = JA through JN

· ***Courts Not Using JIS :***

- o Juvenile - report as the appropriate case type on the monthly Juvenile & Circuit Division summary forms.

ROC? - Not Applicable

Effective Date - Indicates the begin date for a new charge code.

Note: In delinquency cases, where the basis for jurisdiction is a criminal offense, enter the state or municipal charge code associated with the alleged offense.
