When it is impracticable to give time off to an employee regularly scheduled to work on any of the above holidays in order to continue essential services, the appointing authority shall allow the employee to record the hours worked as compensatory time. The appointing authority shall allow the employee to take appropriate compensatory time off at such time or times as the appointing authority shall designate. The preceding does not apply to employees who by virtue of their management position, are not authorized to accrue compensatory time.
