**Treatment Court Program Status** 

As of December 31, 2009, there were 122 treatment court programs: 80 adult, 17 juvenile, 13 family, 9 designated DWI and 3 reintegration court programs. The commission provides funding to 118 of these programs in 53 treatment court jurisdictions.

## **Treatment Court Program Participants**

During the 2009 reporting period, 5,599 individuals participated in a treatment court program.

As of December 31, 2009, there have been a total of 8,578 treatment court program graduates statewide.

A total of 480 babies have been born to female treatment court program participants. 438 were born drug free.
