
AMENDED ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Pursuant to Court operating Rule 103.03(b), the Supreme Court has determined that effective September 1, 2011, if a court digitizes, records, scans, or otherwise reproduces a document that is filed in paper into an electronic record, document, or image, the electronic record, document or image is the official court record. The court may then destroy the paper document unless that document is required to be preserved by law or court order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED effective September 1, 2015, all divisions in Douglas County may proceed under COR 103.03(b) to the extent that the official court record shall be the records which have been converted to or initiated and maintained in an electronic format. Further, the paper document may also be destroyed unless that document is required to be preserved by law or court order.

This Order pertains to new cases filed effective September 1, 2015. Those cases will be available by E-CASE only. A paper file will not be maintained by the Circuit Clerk's Office.
