

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER FOR THE 9<sup>TH</sup> JUDICIAL CIRCUIT


Pursuant to Court Operating Rule 27.01, the Missouri Court Automation Committee has determined that effective December 9, 2013 the following documents, except those filed by self-represented parties, shall be filed electronically in the 9<sup>th</sup> Judicial Circuit which includes Linn, Chariton, and Sullivan Counties:

| All      | All probate, excluding mental health cases  | New filings/subsequent pleadings in all cases, excluding wills, bonds, and receipts |
| All      | All criminal cases including municipal trial de novo cases, traffic, infractions, watercraft and conservation cases | Subsequent pleadings in all cases   |
| All      | All domestic relations case types, including paternity, except for orders of protection                             | New filings/subsequent pleadings in all cases                                       |
| All      | All associate civil cases   | New filings/subsequent pleadings in all cases                                       |
| All      | Circuit civil cases   | New filings/subsequent pleadings in all cases                                       |
