It is hereby ordered that:

Group 1, consisting of the Normandy Hub (Bellerive Acres, Cool Valley, Country Club Hills, Glen Echo Park, Greendale, Normandy, Pasadena Hills, Pasadena Park, Uplands Park); St. Ann Hub (Beverly Hills, Charlack, Northwoods, St. Ann, Vinita Park, Wellston); Creve Coeur, Dellwood, Hazelwood, Jennings, Moline Acres, Shrewsbury and Warson Woods utilize Show-Me Courts no later than September 14, 2018.

Group 2, consisting of the St. Louis County Municipal Division utilize Show-Me Courts <u>no later than January</u> <u>25, 2019</u>.

Group 3, consisting of Ballwin, Bel-Nor, Berkeley, Black Jack, Bridgeton, Calverton Park, Champ, Crestwood, Des Peres, Eureka, Fenton, Flordell Hills, Glendale, Lakeshire, Manchester, Maryland Heights, Oakland, Overland, Pine Lawn, St. John, Sycamore Hills, Valley Park, Velda City, Webster Groves, Wildwood, Winchester and Woodson Terrace utilize Show-Me Courts no later than November 8, 2018.

Group 4, consisting of Bellefontaine Neighbors, Breckenridge Hills, Brentwood, Chesterfield, Clarkson Valley, Clayton, Edmundson, Ferguson, Florissant, Frontenac, Grantwood Village, Hanley Hills, Hillsdale, Kirkwood, LaDue, Maplewood, Olivette, Pagedale, Richmond Heights, Riverview, Rock Hill, Sunset Hills, Town and Country, University City and Velda Village Hills utilize Show-Me Courts no later than March 1, 2019.

It is further ordered that eFiling will be required by all groups (1-4) <u>no later than May 1, 2019</u>. eFiling preparation will be provided as follows:

- Group 1 March 1-15, 2019
- Group 2 March 15-29, 2019
- Group 3 April 1-12, 2019
- Group 4 April 12-26, 2019
