In this personal injury action, Charlotte Benton (Plaintiff) appeals the trial court's judgment granting a motion to dismiss in favor of Cracker Barrel Old Country Stores, Inc., (Defendant). On appeal, Plaintiff contends that the trial court erred in dismissing her petition after concluding that her claim was barred by the Illinois statute of limitations, as applied by Missouri's borrowing statute, § 516.190, RSMo.

## AFFIRMED.

<u>Division IV Holds</u>: The trial court did not err in granting Defendant's motion to dismiss and dismissing Plaintiff's petition because her personal injury action originated in Illinois, where her injuries were sustained, and therefore, her claim was barred by Illinois' two-year statute of limitations and by § 516.190, RSMo.
