Pursuant to Section 455.067.3 RSMo:		
"At any time during the duration of the order recognizing the foreign order of protection, the Respondent may move the court to modify or set aside its order recognizing the full order of protection. Such motion shall be heard only if a copy of the		

court to modify of set aside its order recognizing the full order of protection. Such motion shall be heard only if a copy of the motion and a summons indicating a date and time certain for such hearing is personally served on the Petitioner, and Respondent shall not be entitled to a continuance of such hearing. Such motion shall be sustained only if the Respondent demonstrates to the court by clear convincing evidence that the Missouri court's order was not issued in compliance with this section. The Petitioner shall not be required to appear or to deny or rebut the allegations or evidence submitted by Respondent in order for the court to deny Respondent's motion."

Instructions to Clerk

- 1. A copy of the order of protection shall be issued to the Petitioner and the law enforcement agency (police or sheriff) in the city or county where the Petitioner resides.
- 2. A copy of the order of protection shall be issued the same day the order is granted to the law enforcement agency responsible for maintaining the Missouri Uniform Law enforcement System (MULES).
