REPRIMAND REQUIREMENTS

1. <u>Compliance with Rules of Professional Conduct:</u>

Respondent shall not engage in conduct that violates the Rules of Professional Conduct.

2. <u>Trust Account Mentor:</u>

- a. Respondent shall, within 30 days of the Court's order, retain a Trust Account Mentor attorney acceptable to the Office of Chief Disciplinary Counsel to set up and organize a client trust account that complies with the Missouri Rules of Professional Conduct and IOLTA.
- b. The Trust Account Mentor shall receive monetary compensation paid by Respondent in a reasonable amount for the time involved in mentoring Respondent.
- 3. <u>Client Trust Account Audits:</u> For a period of one year following the Court's order, Respondent shall submit to audits of Respondent's trust account conducted by the Office of Chief Disciplinary Counsel or an auditor of the Chief Disciplinary Counsel's choice. The audits shall be at Respondent's expense and may be conducted at random times.
