- **During my tenure as a St. Louis City Counselor, I was a member of the litigation section and was responsible for medical malpractice defense litigation for St. Louis City Hospital and Regional Hospital. I conducted jury trials and obtained a unanimous defense verdict as first chair. When I served as a second chair, I conducted testimony of expert witnesses that I deposed.**
  - **During my tenure as a Corporation Counsel for Oakland County in Michigan, I represented the County in countless mental health commitment bench trials. I revised the professional services contract being used and was selected to present the revised contract to vendors at meetings for vendors presenting bids to Oakland County for professional services.**
  - **As an Americorp Attorney for Legal Services of Northeast Ohio, I represented low-income clients in landlord tenant actions, administrative public benefit hearings and Maguson-Moss consumer lawsuits.**
  - **As a Guardian ad Litem, I represented the best interest of children in protective custody hearings, adjudications, adoption hearings, review hearings, guardianship hearings, visitation motions, team meetings and adoption staffings. I honored statutory time frames on abuse and neglect cases and helped the Family Court-Juvenile Division of the 22nd Judicial Circuit to be recognized with a Permanency Award for conducting review hearings within the milestones for four consecutive years.**
  - **As an Administrative Hearing Officer for the City of St. Louis Parking Commission, I worked in a judicial role conducting administrative hearings for contested parking violations and emergency hearings for booted and towed vehicles. Violations included expired meters, over the time limit, street cleaning, derelict vehicles, vehicles not lawfully parked at the curb, vehicles parked at the fire hydrant, vehicles parked in the bus zone, no valid license plate, and sign violations. I determined whether the citizen was liable, liable with a reduction, or not liable. Litigants had the appellate remedy to appeal my ruling with the Circuit Court of St. Louis/22<sup>nd</sup> Judicial Circuit. I controlled the decorum of the proceeding, including oral testimony and the presentation of physical evidence, such as records or photographs. Many of the hearings involved pro se litigants. After the giving full consideration to the evidence presented and the applicable ordinance, I issued a ruling and prepared a written finding of facts and conclusions of law.**
