

Announcement

The circuit courts of the 23rd Judicial Circuit and the circuit clerk's office will begin its mandatory electronic filing policy April 29, 2013.

All attorneys and law offices will be required to electronically file all case initiation documents and all subsequent documents and pleadings from that date forward.

Electronic filing procedures and requirements to enable electronic filing, as well as procedures and requirements for various types of cases, are accessible from links on the [court's website](#).

Attorneys will be required to have an [electronic debit account set up](#) to file any cases or an account [payment procedure](#) set up with the circuit clerk's office with sufficient funds at all times to cover the filing costs in all cases electronically filed.

Information about [educational webinars](#) also is accessible from the court's website. These webinars should be completed by attorneys or their support staff to avoid any inability to file cases as of April 29, 2013.

The 23rd Judicial Circuit no longer will mail hard copies of Adjourn Day Dockets after the May Adjourn Docket because the Missouri eFiling System will notify all attorneys about cases on such dockets.
