





- On average, over 12,200 cases were filed with the 19th Circuit Court and FCC each year.
 - Filings increased over the 5-yr period by approximately 770 each year.
- By count, the largest increases in filings were with the FCC and in misdemeanor/etc., associate civil/small claims and circuit civil cases, while the largest decrease was in traffic/ordinance cases.
- Misdemeanor/municipal certification/trial de novo cases accounted for nearly one-third of the court's caseload, while associate civil/small claims accounted for one-fifth and domestic relations for approximately one-sixth (see below).
