
Treatment Court Program Status

Currently there are 122 operational treatment courts: 80 adult, 17 juvenile, 13 family, 3 reintegration and 9 designated DWI. The commission provided funding to 53 treatment court jurisdictions that include 118 operational treatment courts.

Admissions

There were 2547 admissions to treatment courts during this reporting period, as measured by a count of cases. Re-entry also includes reintegration case types.

Admissions by Case Type Category



Pre-plea case types, as a percentage of all adult case types, have decreased 4% from what was reported for FY09. The increase was spread over post-plea, probation and re-entry case types. Of the family and juvenile case types, pre-adjudicated case types have decreased nearly 8% from FY09 due primarily to a drop in the number of family pre-adjudicated cases.

*Data as measured by a count of participants at the time of admission to treatment court. Reintegration, DWI and family drug court case type participants are included. Juvenile drug court participants are not included.

The number of males admitted as a percentage of total adults admitted has increased nearly 4% from what was reported in FY09. The number of whites admitted as a percentage of total adults admitted has increased by nearly 5% from what was reported in FY09.

The following is also known about all adults admitted to treatment court during CY09:

- The average age at admission was 30.
- Admissions range in age from 17 to 75.

Exits

Termination includes termination, voluntary withdrawal, administrative discharge and dismissal docket types.

*Includes exit information as measured by a count of cases for reintegration, DWI and adult, family and juvenile drug courts. Multiple exits for the same participant are included.

As of 12/31/2009 there have been a total of 8645 treatment court graduates.

A total of 487 babies have been born to female participants during treatment. **445 of these have been born drug-free.**

- 53 drug-free babies were born to participants that exited treatment court during this reporting period.
- 9 drug-exposed babies were born to participants that exited treatment court during this reporting period.
