New applicants should ask the persons whom you list as references to write a letter to the Chief Judge, with a copy to each Commissioner, stating their opinion of your judicial qualifications. Do not use judges as references.

Applicants should attach a brief biographical sketch to their application for publication purposes in the event the applicant is selected as one of the three nominees. A copy of the applications of the three nominees submitted to the Governor will be made public within 72 hours of submitting the certificate of nomination; personal or confidential information will be redacted.
