OPINION SUMMARY

Cheung Rockwell appeals the judgment denying her petition to divide an asset not divided in her dissolution of marriage to James M. Wong and her motion for constructive trust. Wong filed two motions, taken with the case, to dismiss Rockwell's appeal arguing, in part, that Rockwell's appeal should be dismissed for failure to comply with Rule 84.04.¹

APPEAL DISMISSED.

Division One holds:

Rockwell's brief substantially fails to comply with Rule 84.04 and preserves nothing for review.
