Darrion Moore (Appellant) appeals from the trial court’s judgment convicting him of attempted first-degree statutory sodomy and sentencing him to ten years in prison.

AFFIRMED.

Division Two Holds: The trial court did not err in denying Appellant’s motion for judgment of acquittal at the close of evidence because the State adduced sufficient evidence from which a reasonable trier of fact could have found that Appellant attempted to engage in deviant sexual intercourse with a victim who was under the age of fourteen, and thus was guilty of attempted first-degree statutory sodomy.
