Kelly S. Keel (Mother) appeals from the trial court's Full and Final Judgment Modifying Family Court Judgment (judgment) entered June 25, 2013.

AFFIRMED.

Division Two Holds: There are sufficient findings in the judgment to support the modification of custody based on a substantial change of circumstances since the original custody decree. There is sufficient evidence in the record that transfer of custody was in the children's best interests. There was no abuse of discretion in assigning the balance of guardian ad litem fees to Mother.
