John C. Duvall appeals the motion court's denial, without findings or conclusions, of his motion to re-open his Rule 29.15 proceedings. He requests remand for entry of findings and conclusions he claims are required, but does not otherwise challenge the correctness of the motion court's denial.

AFFIRMED.

Division Two holds: Duvall's motion did not assert any cognizable basis for re-opening his Rule 29.15 proceedings because he did not state a true claim of abandonment by post-conviction counsel. The correctness of the motion court's denial is clear. Therefore, findings and conclusions were not required.
