The Director of Revenue of the State of Missouri (“Director”) appeals from the judgments of the trial court that ordered the Director to remove the administrative-alcohol suspension from Matthew Bartholomew’s (“Driver”) driving record and to reinstate Driver’s driving and CDL privileges.

REVERSED AND REMANDED.

DIVISION ONE HOLDS: The trial court misapplied the law by failing to apply the savings clause provision of 19 CSR 25-30.051(8) (2012), and improperly excluded the maintenance report on the breathalyzer used to determine the blood alcohol content of Driver, which was performed in compliance with the rules in effect at the time that the maintenance was conducted.
