The petitioner, Michael Grzybinski, appeals the judgment of the Circuit Court of St. Charles County sustaining the administrative suspension of his driver’s license by the Director of Revenue. The petitioner asks this Court to order the suspension of driving privileges stricken from his record and the reinstatement of those privileges.

APPEAL DISMISSED.

DIVISION THREE HOLDS: The Director of Revenue had already expunged the administrative suspension from the petitioner’s driving record pursuant to section 302.545 RSMo. (Supp. 2013) prior to briefing, oral argument, and submission of this appeal. Therefore, we hold the dispute between the parties is rendered moot, and dismiss the appeal.
