Robert J. Willey appeals from a sentence and judgment of conviction for robbery in the first degree and burglary in the first degree. He argues there was insufficient evidence supporting his conviction for the burglary charge.

AFFIRMED.

Division Two Holds: The trial court did not err in entering judgment against Appellant on the charge of burglary in the first degree. The evidence here was sufficient to establish that Appellant knew he did not have permission to enter Victim's home, and thus the State thus proved the element of unlawful entry beyond a reasonable doubt.
