Pamela Demars (Wife) appeals the judgment of contempt of the Circuit Court of St. Charles County ordering her to transfer 960 shares of stock to Gary Buntенbach (Husband).

AFFIRMED.

Division Four Holds: The trial court's contempt judgment did not amend or modify the terms of the dissolution judgment in violation of Rule 75.01. Because the dissolution judgment awarded Husband 96 shares of Wife's unvested MasterCard stock and the stock split ten-to-one before it vested, Husband was entitled to the resulting 960 shares. In ordering Wife to transfer to Husband 960 shares of MasterCard stock, the trial court was merely acting to enforce its prior judgment.
