Zachary Smith (Claimant) appeals from the decision of the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission (Commission) denying his claim for unemployment compensation benefits. The Commission found that Claimant was disqualified for benefits because he voluntarily quit his job without good cause attributable to his work or the employer.

**AFFIRMED.**

**Division II Holds:**

The Commission properly determined that Claimant was not entitled to unemployment compensation benefits because there was competent and substantial evidence to support its finding that Claimant voluntarily quit his job without good cause attributable to his work or the employer.
