Certain Underwriters at Lloyd's, London, Beazley Underwriting, Ltd. ("Appellants") appeal from the trial court's denial of Appellant's oral motion to intervene and the trial court's denial of Appellant's Renewed Motion to Intervene and Motion to Set Aside Judgment and Motion for New Trial. The trial court's denial of the Motion to Intervene of June 8, 2015, is affirmed. The appeal from the August 27, 2015 Order denying the motion of July 7, 2015, is dismissed for lack of jurisdiction.

AFFIRMED in part, DISMISSED in part.

Division One Holds: The trial court orally denied Appellant's oral motion to intervene in the action. This denial was never reduced to writing, signed by the judge, denominated a "judgment," or filed. Thus, the trial court's oral denial cannot be considered a judgment for purposes of appeal. Further, this court lacks jurisdiction to review the trial court's August 27, 2015 Order, as the trial court correctly found that it lost jurisdiction to hear the Motion to Intervene thirty days after the judgment. Therefore, we do not have jurisdiction to hear the appeal.
