Paul Corrington Fike (Husband) and Susan Knabe Fike (Wife) appeal the trial court's second amended judgment arguing twelve separate points on appeal. We affirm in part and reverse in part.

AFFIRMED IN PART AND REVERSED IN PART.

Division Two Holds: The trial court did not err or abuse its discretion in determining the value of the marital property, equitably dividing the marital property, determining Husband's income for purposes of child support and maintenance, declining to base any part of its judgment on a finding of marital fault, classifying the marital home as marital property, ordering Wife to pay the HELOC associated with the marital home, or in its award of attorney's fees.

We find the court did err in awarding Husband two diamonds from Wife's engagement ring because testimony at trial showed the ring was a gift made to Wife prior to her marriage and was therefore her separate property.
