William Norath appeals from the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission’s (“Commission”) determination that he was overpaid unemployment benefits and that he willfully and fraudulently failed to report to the Division of Employment Security (“Division”) wages he had earned.

REVERSED AND REMANDED.

DIVISION THREE HOLDS: The Commission failed to make a finding regarding whether Norath was working for Hackmann Lumber Company part-time, full-time, or not at all during the weeks at issue, and failed to determine when Norath’s wages were earned. Without these factual determinations, we are unable to meaningfully review the Commission’s decision, and as a result, its decision must be reversed and the cause remanded so that the Commission can resolve these issues.
