Dale Wright (Movant) appeals the judgment of the Circuit Court of St. Louis County denying his Rule 29.15 motion for post-conviction relief without an evidentiary hearing. On appeal, Movant argues that the motion court erred when it denied his Rule 29.15 motion because he pleaded facts, unrefuted by the record, that his counsel was ineffective for failing to object when the prosecutor called Movant a child molester during closing arguments.
