Wasse Zafer and Zafer Chiropractic & Sports Injuries, P.A. (collectively “Appellants”) appeal the Circuit Court of Lincoln County’s judgment on the pleadings in favor of Andy Hermann (“Hermann”) and Farmers Insurance Company, Inc. (“Farmers”), dismissing Appellants’ claims for (1) breach of contract, (2) tortious interference with a business expectancy, (3) abuse of process, (4) breach of fiduciary duty, and (5) negligence.
