Massigh Stallman (Appellant) appeals from the trial court’s judgment entered upon a jury verdict convicting him of, among other charges, second-degree felony murder.

AFFIRMED.

Division Three Holds: The trial court did not err in overruling Appellant’s motion for judgment of acquittal of second-degree felony murder, as the State presented sufficient evidence from which a reasonable juror might have found Appellant guilty of said charge beyond a reasonable doubt, in that his felony assault on a police officer and immediate flight therefrom was a proximate cause of a responding officer’s death in a fatal car accident.
