Husband appeals *pro se*. He brings this seven point appeal, raising issues from this dissolution judgment, a previous pendente lite judgment, and a previous dissolution judgment.

DISMISSED IN PART; AFFIRMED IN PART.

Division II Holds: Husband failed to appeal timely from the prior pendente lite and dissolution judgments. Accordingly, those points on appeal are dismissed. The points on appeal regarding the 2007 dissolution judgment present no error of law and have been disposed of in a memorandum opinion pursuant to Rule 84.16(b).
