George W. Carlisle, Jr. appeals from the trial court's judgment granting Peggy R. Carlisle a full order of protection against him pursuant to the Missouri Adult Abuse Act, Sections 455.010-455.090, RSMo Cum. Supp. 2006.¹

DISMISSED.

Division IV Holds: We decline to exercise our discretion to hear Husband's moot appeal of the grant of a full order of protection against him pursuant to the Adult Abuse Act because his appeal does not fall within either exception to the mootness doctrine. The appeal is dismissed.
