Melinda Clement ("Claimant") appeals the determination of the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission ("Commission") denying unemployment benefits on the basis of its finding that Claimant failed, without good cause, to accept an offer of suitable work from a former employer.

REVERSED AND REMANDED.

Division Three Holds: The Commission's finding that Claimant refused an offer of suitable work from a former employer and denying her unemployment benefits was not supported by competent and substantial evidence because there was no evidence the work offered was suitable.
