OPINION SUMMARY

Karen King Mitchell, Director of Revenue, appeals the judgment ordering the Director to expunge all records of S.S.'s administrative alcohol suspension and to make those records confidential under section 577.054 RSMo Supp. 2007.¹

AFFIRMED.

Southern Division holds: Based upon the plain and ordinary language of the July 2005 amendment to section 577.054.1, and the state of the law at the time the legislature enacted the amendment, section 577.054.1, as amended, authorizes courts to expunge all records of a driver's administrative alcohol suspension and to make those records confidential.
