Christine Hernandez (“Hernandez”) appeals the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission’s (“the Commission”) decision to deny her unemployment benefits.

REVERSED AND REMANDED

Division Two Holds: The Commission erred in requiring Hernandez to present scientific evidence of a causal connection and in finding that there was no causal connection between Hernandez’s pregnancy, back pain and sitting for long periods. We reverse and remand to the Commission to calculate an award of benefits.
